Inaugural Live Transmission of Endoscopy Cases to Siriraj Hospital, Bangkok, Bach Mai Hospital, Hanoi and Asan Medical Center, Seoul

This year for the first time ever, endoscopic procedures at our annual endoscopy workshop, Endoscopy 2012, will be transmitted live to Siriraj GI Scope Center in Bangkok, Thailand, Gastrointestinal Endoscopy Unit in Hanoi, Vietnam and Department of Gastroenterology, Asan Medical Center in Seoul, Korea.

Siriraj Hospital is one of the largest hospitals in the region with 2,500 beds and houses Mahidol's University Faculty of Medicine. The GI Scope Center is one of 14 World Gastrointestinal Organisation (WGO) training centers and was opened on 20th March 2006. Dr Thawatchai Akaraviputh, Assistant Professor of Department of Surgery, Mahidol University and one of the training center's instructor will be joining us with his colleagues.

Bach Mai Hospital is the biggest hospital in the North of Vietnam with 1,900 beds and houses the Gastrointestinal Endoscopy Unit - Functional Examination Department which is run by eight doctors. Annually, a total of 21,000 endoscopy procedures were performed in this unit; 15,000 gastroscopies, 5,000 colonoscopies and 1,000 therapeutic endoscopies. Endoscopist from the Functional Examination Department, Dr Tran Viet Hung and his colleagues will be joining us.

With an area greater than 3 million sq. ft. and with 2,791 beds, Asan Medical Center is the largest hospital in Korea. The Department of Gastroenterology, located on the West Building operates a Liver Disease Team, a Pancreatic Disease Center, a Biliary Disease Center, an Upper Gastrointestinal Disease Center, a Lower Gastrointestinal Disease Center, and an Endoscopy Center. Dr Dong Wan Seo, an Associate Professor in the Department of Gastroenterology will be joining us.

The live procedures will be transmitted using H323 equipment capable of connecting up to eight stations simultaneously in full High Definition (Full HD, 1080p) using Malaysian Research and Education Network 2 (MYREN2) through Trans-Eurasia Information Network 3 (TEIN3) to Bangkok via Thailand Research and Education Network, ThaiREN (Uni Net2 and Thailand Social/Scientific, Academic and Research Network 3, Thaisarn3), Hanoi via VinaREN (Vietnam Research and Education Network) and Seoul via KOREN (Korea Advanced Research Network). This transmission is facilitated by Associate Professor Dr Salem Omar from the Department of Medicine, Faculty of Medicine, University of Malaya, University Malaya Medical Centre Information Technology's Network Unit team headed by Mr Mohamad Zahir Ahmad and MYREN team headed by Mr Kamal Hisham Kamaruddin. Associate Professor Dr Salem is the current Chair, MYREN Medical Working Group, member of Asia Pacific Advanced Network (APAN) Medical Working Group and member of Electronic Media Committee, World Endoscopy Organization (WEO). This annual endoscopy workshop will be registered from this year as a Special Working Group, a subgroup of the APAN Medical Working Group. There are plans to connect more international centers to our future annual endoscopy workshop. Indeed this annual endoscopic workshop will soon be recognised internationally.

Robert Hawes ORLANDO, USA

Professor Hawes is currently Consultant Therapeutic Endoscopist, Florida Hospital Institute for Minimally Invasive Therapies (FHIMIT) and Professor of Medicine, University of Central Florida School of Medicine at Orlando, USA. He was previously Professor of Medicine with Professor Peter Cotton, at the Medical University of South Carolina at Charlestown for many years. An outstanding endoscopist and a teacher par excellence, Rob is a highly sought after faculty in live endoscopy workshops. He was President of the American Society for Gastrointestinal Endoscopy in 2005/2006.

Hiroshi Kashida OSAKA, JAPAN

Dr Hiroshi Kashida is Professor of Medicine at the Department of Gastroenterology and Hepatology and Chief of Endoscopy, Kinki University Faculty of Medicine. A graduate of the prestigious University of Kyoto in 1983, Professor Kashida worked in several centres including in the famous Showa University, Northern Yokohama Hospital under the legendary Professor Shin-ei Kudo. An expert colonoscopist, Professor Kashida is adept at diagnosis of early colonic neoplasms as well as in endoscopic submucosal dissection of early colonic tumors.



Sang-Hyub Lee SEOUL, KOREA

Dr Lee is Assistant Professor, Seoul National University Bundang Hospital. A graduate of the famous Seoul National University in 1970, Dr Lee is a therapeutic endoscopist who has now developed a special focus in ERCPs and pancreatobiliary endoscopy. An expert in stenting of malignant strictures in the biliary tree, Dr Lee is considered an expert in the use of metallic stents.

Claudio Navarette-Garcia SANTIAGO, CHILE

Dr Navarette is the Director of Endoscopy and Chief of Digestive Diseases at the Clinica Alemana de Santiago and Professor at the Faculty of Medicine, University of Desarrollo and the University of Chile, Santiago, Chile. The Clinica Alemana is a World Gastroenterology Organization (WGO) Training Centre and a World Endoscopy Organization Center of Excellence. A top-class therapeutic endoscopist and well respected teacher, Dr Navarette has now trained numerous GI endoscopists from South America and other parts of the world in his Centre.

Paulo Sakai SAO PAULO, BRAZIL

Dr Sakai is Associate Professor at the Gastrointestinal Endoscopy Unit, University of Sao Paulo Medical School. A well respected teacher and highly skilled and innovative endoscopist, he is also an Honorary Member of ASGE. Professor Sakai runs a highly successful annual therapeutic endoscopy workshop in his unit in Sao Paulo every year. The GI Endoscopy Unit of Sao Paulo University Medical School has also been accorded the honor of being a World Endoscopy Organization Center of Excellence.

Rajvinder Singh ADELAIDE, AUSTRALIA

Dr Rajvinder Singh is Senior Consultant Gastroenterologist, The Lyell McEwin Hospital and Senior Clinical Lecturer, Department of Medicine, University of Adelaide, Australia. A Malaysian by birth, Dr Rajvinder is an outstanding gastroenterologist and interventional endoscopist. After his gastroenterology fellowship in Malaysia, Rajvinder worked in the famous Wolfson Digestive Diseases Centre, QMC, Nottingham, UK, under Professor Krish Ragnath from 2006-2008 and subsequently obtained his M Phil degree from the University of Nottingham. Since 2008, he has worked in Adelaide where he has continued to develop his interest in image enhanced endoscopy in both the upper and lower gastrointestinal tracts.



Hsiu-Po Wang TAIPEI, TAIWAN

Dr Wang is Associate Professor at the prestigious National Taiwan University (NTU) and Chief of Endoscopy at the NTU Hospital. A top-class endoscopist, Professor Wang has a wide ineprest in therapeutic endoscopy but with special focus on ERCPs and pancreatobiliary disease. He is a member of several important endoscopy groups in the Asia Pacific region including the New Frontiers Endoscopy Forum and has been invited to perform in numerous live endoscopy workshops.



Kenshi Yao FUKUOKA, JAPAN

Dr Yao is Associate Professor at Fukuoka and Head of Department of Endoscopy, Chikushi Hospital, Fukuoka University. Professor Yao has a special interest in early diagnosis of gastric cancers and early neoplastic lesions and image enhanced endoscopy of the upper gastrointestinal tract. He has built up a reputation as one of the top authorities in this area where he is considered as the best in the world today.

Citation by Dato' Dr Ryan Ponnudurai



Rob Hawes grew up in Bloomington, Indiana. He attended Indiana University and was Board Certified in Gastroenterology under the tutelage of his mentor Professor Glen Lehman. Dr Hawes proceeded to spend a year in London, England (1985-1986), doing an Advanced Endoscopy Fellowship concentrating on ERCP and endoscopic laser therapy under the direction of Peter B Cotton and Steve Bown respectively.

Dr Hawes returned to Indiana University in the fall of 1986 and served on the faculty in the Division of Gastroenterology from 1986-1994. During this time, he was promoted from Assistant to Associate and ultimately to Full Professor in July of 1994. After being introduced to endoscopic ultrasound at the Middlesex Hospital, he established the EUS program at IU in 1987; one of the first five training centers in the US. He continued his work in pancreatobiliary endoscopy and established a multi modality treatment center for the non-operative management of gallstones.

In July of 1994, Dr Hawes re-connected with Peter Cotton and moved to the Medical University of South Carolina (MUSC) in Charleston to form a new Digestive Disease Center. This center is designed to facilitate the integration of GI medicine, surgery and radiology into an integrated unit to promote patient care, research, and technology development to treat patients with digestive diseases. During his tenure at MUSC, the institution became recognized nationally and internationally for excellence in EUS, ERCP and therapeutic endoscopy.

Dr Hawes served on several committees and the governing board of the American Society for Gastrointestinal Endoscopy (ASGE). Dr Hawes went on to serve as President of the ASGE in 2005-2006. Immediately following his ASGE presidency, he was instrumental in forming the Natural Orifice Surgery Consortium for Assessment and Research (NOSCAR) committee. The goal of this joint ASGE/SAGES committee was to develop a new paradigm in minimally invasive surgery called NOTES (natural orifice transluminal endoscopic surgery).

Dr Hawes has published over 250 peer-reviewed articles and written numerous book chapters. He has lectured and performed live demonstrations in over 30 countries throughout Europe, Asia and the Americas. He has visited our country many times in the past and has taken a keen interest in the development of endoscopic ultrasound in Asia. In 2006, MUSC awarded Dr Hawes the Peter B Cotton Endowed Chair for Endoscopic Innovation.

Recently in January 2012, Dr Hawes has moved to Florida Hospital Orlando to build an institute for minimally invasive therapies to further integrate therapeutic endoscopy and minimally invasive surgery.


