

### Objectives and Format of Workshop

Emphasis on practical tips in therapeutic endoscopy: technique, indications limitations and pitfalls. In particular in this year's workshop we will be introducing several new sophisticated procedures which we want our participants to learn, appreciate their utility but at the same to be critical about its application and usefulness in our daily clinical practice.

Procedures will include direct cholangioscopy, probe cholangioscopy, use of various metallic stents, per oral endoscopic myotomy (POEM), radiofrequency ablation of Barrett's esophagus, radiofrequency ablation of intraductal biliary tumors and pancreatic tumors through EUS puncture.

Dr Khor is Director of the Endoscopy Center and Consultant at the Singapore General Hospital. He had also trained at the National Cancer Center Hospital, Tokyo, learning in performing ESDs. He has a great wealth of experience in teaching endoscopy and is a popular faculty member in endoscopy workshops throughout the region.

**SUNDEEP LAKHTAKIA** Hyderabad, India

Dr Lakhtakia is a faculty member of the world-renowned Asian Institute of Gastroenterology in Hyderabad. He trained in Internal Medicine and Gastroenterology at the Sanjay Gandhi Post-Graduate Institute of Medical Sciences, Lucknow, and the Post-Graduate Institute of Medical Education and Research, Chandigarh. A surgeon by training, Dr Maydeo is now a fulltime dedicated therapeutic endoscopist. He is a Past-President of the Society of the Gastrointestinal Endoscopy of India and is internationally recognised as a top therapeutic endoscopist in the world today. He is adept in a whole range of therapeutic endoscopic procedures, and runs well-received teaching endoscopy workshops in his institute for many years now. Recently, he has been in the forefront in the teaching and promotion of the use of POEM in the treatment of achalasia of the cardia.

**JONG-HO MOON** Bucheon, Korea

Jong-Ho Moon is Chief, Division of Gastroenterology and Director, Digestive Disease Center, Soon Chun Hyang University, Bucheon Hospital. He is Professor, Division of Gastroenterology, Department of Medicine, and Soon Chun Hyang University School of Medicine in Bucheon Korea. He has worked throughout his professional career at the Soon Chun Hyang Teaching Hospital system but also had a training stint at the University of Washington School of Medicine, Seattle, USA, from 2004 to 2005. Professor Moon is one of the most gifted therapeutic biliopancreatic endoscopists and is adept in all the difficult ERCP procedures. He is a pioneer in direct cholangioscopy through the use of the ultrathin gastroscope.

**ROY SOETIKNO** Singapore

Roy Soetikno was Clinical Professor of Medicine at the Stanford University, Palo Alto, California, USA. He graduated from the University of Chicago, Pritzker School of Medicine. Previous to this, he studied chemical engineering as an undergraduate passing cum laude from the University of Washington, St Louis, Missouri. In January 2015, he moved to Singapore where he is now Consultant Gastroenterologist at the Singapore General Hospital and Professor at the Dukes University-Singapore Medical School based at the Singapore General Hospital. Professor Soetikno is well-known for his work on image enhanced endoscopy with special focus on the use of NBI.



**KENNETH WANG** Rochester, USA

Ken Wang is Professor of Medicine at the world famous Mayo Clinic in Rochester, USA. A graduate of the illustrious University of Michigan. He has, over the years, developed a name for himself in the diagnosis and treatment of Barrett's esophagus of which he is a leading world authority. In addition, he has deep interest in endoscopy and has been closely involved in educational activities of the American Society of GI Endoscopy (ASGE) which culminated in him being President of this august society from 2013 to 2014.

Citation by *Dr Chan Wah Keong* (Associate Professor and Consultant Gastroenterologist, University of Malaya)



Professor Ken Wang is Professor of Medicine at the Mayo Medical School, Rochester, Minnesota. He is Co-Director of the Gastrointestinal Cancer Program at the Mayo Comprehensive Cancer Centre, Director of the Advanced Endoscopy Group, and Director of the Barrett's Esophagus Unit in the Mayo Division of Gastroenterology and Hepatology. He also holds the Kathy and Russ Van Cleve Endowed Professorship in Gastroenterology Research.

Professor Ken Wang received his Bachelor of Science from the University of Michigan in 1978 and his Medical Degree from the Wayne State University School of Medicine in 1982. He completed his Residency in Internal Medicine in 1985 and Fellowship in Gastroenterology in 1988 at the prestigious Mayo Graduate School of Medicine. He has been a dedicated staff at the Mayo Clinic since then, respected and admired by his peers. Professor Ken Wang is a highly-respected endoscopist worldwide. He became a member of the American Society of Gastrointestinal Endoscopy (ASGE) in 1990. He served on ASGE's Governing Board since 2002 and was secretary from 2009 to 2012 before becoming President-Elect from 2012 to 2013. In 2013 to 2014, Ken Wang was President of the ASGE, a position which he held with high distinction. He continues to be actively involved in many activities of the ASGE. He chaired the Guidelines Committee of the World Organization of Digestive Endoscopy (Organisation Mondiale d'Endoscopie Digestive, OMED).

Professor Ken Wang is the recipient of many grants and awards and is a frequent speaker at national and international meetings. He has authored over 500 publications, abstracts and book chapters, and has been a reviewer for Gastrointestinal Endoscopy, the American Journal of Gastroenterology, Clinical Gastroenterology and Hepatology, and the New England Journal of Medicine, among many others. His clinical interests include Barrett's esophagus, esophageal cancer, ablation therapy, optical biopsy, confocal laser microscopy, and endoscopic mucosal resection/dissection.

Ken Wang is a Professor and gastroenterologist par excellence. It is my singular honor and privilege to introduce to you our Distinguished Lecturer for 2015.


